Criteria for the selection of the recipient of the annual CCA Memorial Scholarship Fund established in honor of Kathryn Stephens.

Central California Alliance is proud to provide financial assistance to the GLBT community through its annual scholarship. The intention of this scholarship fund is to provide support to active members of the community who are currently enrolled in or have applied to college as an undergraduate.

Recipients, to be chosen annually, will receive a \$1000 award.

ELIGIBILITY - All applicants must:

- Identify as GLBT+
- Be enrolled or have applied to college as a full-time undergraduate student
- Reside for at least six months in any of the following counties - Fresno, Madera, Tulare, Kings, Merced
- Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average
- Be an active supporter of the GLBT+ community

REQUIREMENTS - All applicants must:

- Complete an application form.
- Provide supporting documentation as requested.
- Provide proof of continued enrollment (i.e. tuition bill, class registration) and previous semester transcript/grades.

- Award recipients will be notified by mail.
- Funds will be disbursed January 30
